## Email as a Government Record

A common misconception exists that all records are on paper. Actually, electronic documentation is as much a record as paper documentation and should be treated as such. One type of electronic record that is frequently generated in government offices is email. One important aspect of managing email is ensuring that record email is maintained within government email accounts. The Council of State Archivist (CoSA), the National Association of Government Archives and Records Administrators (NAGARA), and the Society of American Archivists (SAA) recently issued a joint statement pointing out several of the hazards associated with using non-government email accounts for conducting public business, including:

- violating the transparency and openness that the public requires from its government
- making it difficult to hold public officials accountable
- unnecessarily mixing government and personal records
- jeopardizing the accessibility of the archival record to the public
