- 1870 (US Census, Baltimore City, Ward 9, Dwell 499, Fam 631) ○
 - At home of Augustus Roberts
 - Age 11
 - Attended school in last year
- 1880 (US Census, Baltimore City, Ward 10, Precinct 2, Dwell 65, Fam 81) ○
 - At home of Augustus Roberts
 - Age 19
 - Son
 - Barber
- 1900 (US Census, Baltimore City, Ward 14, District 0181, Dwell 46, Fam 54) ○
 - Address: 642 George Street
 - Age 39
 - Born Apr 1861
 - Listed as son-in-law but apparently should be brother-in-law (see Note 2 below)

NOTES

1. This is probably an error. In all previous censuses he's listed as Mulatto. In the city directories he's identified as "colored."
2. In the 1910 Census (Baltimore City, Ward 17, District 286, Dwell 161, Fam 224), Agnes V Roberts is listed as a widow, Mulatto, and the sister of Helen V Bishop. So Henry must have died between 1900 and 1910.
3. Probably an error since she, her sister (Helen V) and niece (Helen E) are listed as Mulatto in 1910 Census.
4. Helen V Bishop is first in the family listing for both the 1900 and 1910 censuses. The 1910 address is 929 Argyle Avenue.
