  - Barber
- 1822-1823 (Matchett's City Directory)
  - Pratt, north side, east of Charles
  - Barber
- Jun 1831 (Matchett's City Directory)
  - 4 Light St
  - Hairdresser
- 1835, 1837-38 (Matchett's City Directory)
  - 4 Light St
  - Barber
- 1842 (Matchett's City Directory)
  - 14 Light St
  - Barber
- 1850 (US Census, Baltimore, Ward 9, Dwell 448, Fam 597)
  - Age 63
  - Barber
  - Born West Indies
  - \$1,000 Real property
  - At same residence
    - Eliza Green, age 38<sup>1</sup>
    - James Cooper, age 17, Barber
    - John Boon, age 14, Barber (Black)
    - Rachel Brown, age 39<sup>2</sup>

- 1851-1859 City Directories (Matchett, Boyd, Wood)
  - 4 Light St
