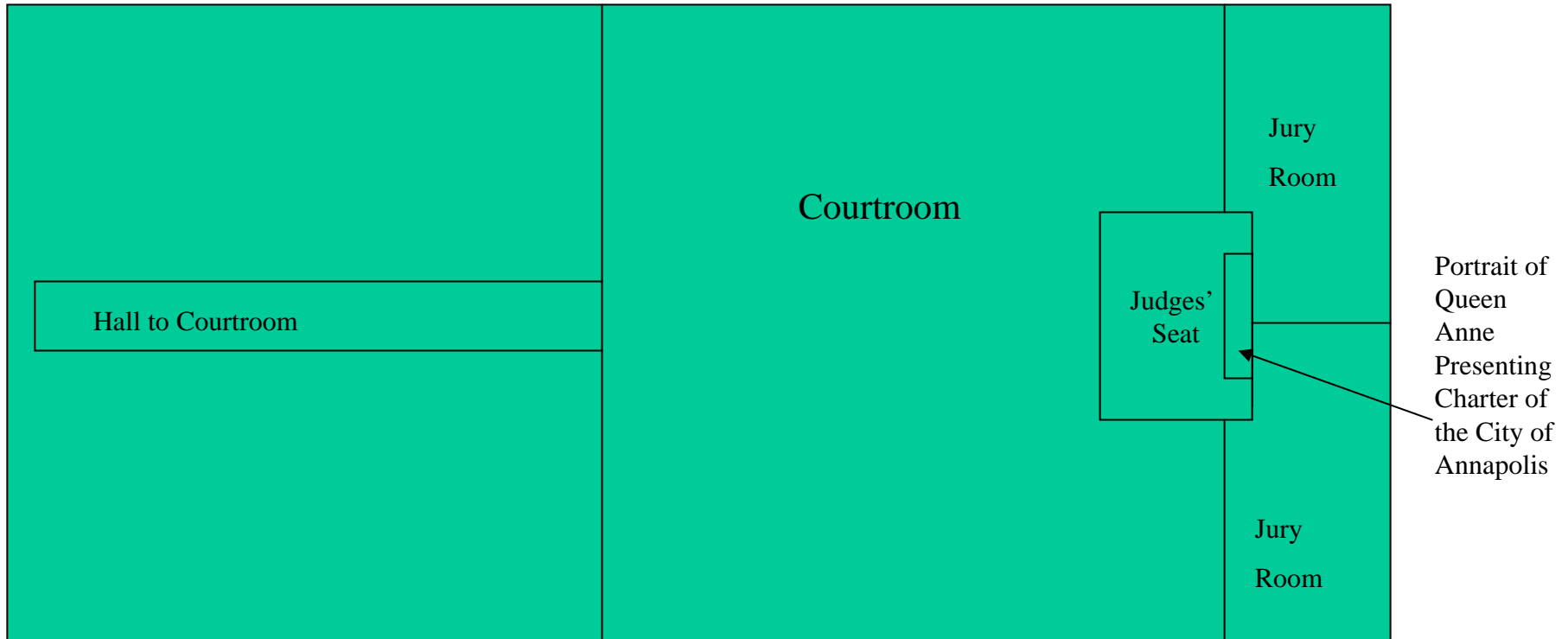


# Courthouse in the Second State House

## First Floor



The Clerk of the Court probably had a loft office in this building. The building is described as having a cupola with balustrades and seats to use for those wishing to “enjoy the beautiful scenery around.” This structure was probably very similar to the first Courthouse in the State House.
