At the Request of Hannah Briggs the following Deed was recorded this 22^d day of June 1795 to wit. **This Indenture** made this twentieth day of January seventeen hundred and ninety five Between Roger Brooke of Montgomery County and state of Maryland of the one part and Hannah Briggs of the same County and state of the other part Witnesseth that the said Roger Brooke for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings current money to him in hand paid by the said Hannah Briggs at or upon the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Roger Brooke doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth hereby grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto her the said Hannah Briggs and her heirs the following tract or parcel of Land being part of several tracts or parcels of Land that is part of a tract called addition to Brooke grove part of a tract called the Resurvey on Brooke Park part of a tract called Fair Hill and part of a tract called Surebind surefind the said tract or parcel of Land hereby granted bargained sold aliened released enfeoffed and confirmed or meant mentioned or intended so to be is contained circumscribed and limited within the bounds courses and distances following that is to say Beginning at a Stone marked **II** it being the end of the second line of Deborah Thomas part of the aforesaid Lands and running with the third line thereof north four and one half degrees West one hundred and three perches to two stones planted north seventy seven and three quarter degrees East one hundred and twenty six perches between a white oak and two black oaks with nine notches each north seventy seven and three quarter degrees East one hundred and thirty perches to a black oak and chestnut marked with nine notches each North seventy seven and three quarter degrees East sixty perches to a stone between two white oak trees marked with nine notches each North sixty nine and one quarter degrees East sixty three and one half perches to the end of thirty eight perches on the one

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hundred and eighty ninth line of Addition to Brooke grove it being the fifth line of a tract called Ridgelys Ridge and with the said line of Addition to Brooke grove south twenty one degrees east forty perches to the end thereof still with said Land south twenty six degrees west thirty three perches then south fifty two and three quarters degrees west ten perches to a stone marked **IV** south fifty two and three quarters degrees west one hundred and sixteen and one half perches to a stone marked **III** between two white oaks with nine notches each south four and one half degrees East thirty nine and one half perches to a stone marked **5** south eighty degrees west forty six perches to a flint stone marked **6** near a white oak with nine notches North four and one half degrees West thirty nine and one half perches south eighty degrees west two hundred and fourteen perches to the first beginning Containing two hundred and forty five acres of Land be the same more or less To have and to hold the said Bargained Lands and premises together with all house buildings and singular the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto her the said Hannah Briggs her heirs and assigns forever and to no other use intent or purpose whatsoever and the said Roger Brooke doth hereby for himself and his heirs Executors and Administrators covenant and grant to and with the said Hannah Briggs that he the said Roger Brooke the said tract or parcel of Land and premises hereby granted or meant mentioned or intended so to be with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereunto appertaining unto the said Hannah Briggs her heirs and assigns against him the said Roger Brooke and his heirs and assigns and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever claiming the same by through or under him or his heirs or assigns shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents and also that he the said Roger Brooke and his heirs and assigns shall and will at all times hereafter upon the reasonable request of her the said Hannah Briggs or her heirs or assigns well and truly do and execute all and every such further and other law full and reasonable act and acts thing and things for the more effectual confirmation of these presents and granting the lands and premises therein mentioned according to the true intent and meaning thereof as by the said Hannah Briggs her heirs or assigns or by her or their Council learned in the law shall be reasonably devised advised or required in witness whereof the said Roger Brooke hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first aforesaid.
